

Soham Staploe Rotary Club will organise the district 1080 quiz again this year.

You and your club members are invited to enter a team to compete in the 2016/17 District 1080 quiz. The structure of the competition will be the same as last year with 1 knockout round for clubs in the new year with a final event held in the Soham area during May 2015. In recent years we've seen around 25 clubs and we are planning the same format and we'll cap entries at 25 clubs on a first come first served basis. Local clubs will be drawn as closely as possible during the knockout round to limit travel. If an odd number of clubs sign up then last year's winning club will receive a bye through to the final.

Teams can consist of up to 6 people and you will need to arrange a question master should your club be required to host a qualifier. The key to this event is fellowship amongst local clubs although you can use your fixture to raise some funds for a good cause. When doing the draw one club will be designated the home team and it is left to them to schedule the match within the given timescale. You may choose to host a qualifying round as part of one of your club nights or as a separate event. In previous years clubs have used the quiz to raise a small amount of money at the qualifying rounds and put it towards their foundation donation. Any money raised during the final will be given to the End Polio Now campaign.
